Supply List

**The following items are the responsibility of the student; these items are not supplied in the classroom by the teacher.*

- 2”-3” Binder with subject dividers
- Looseleaf Notebook paper
- Colored Pencils (**optional**; some students prefer to use their own)
- Colored Pens (used for self-checking papers)
- Highlighters
- #2 Pencils
- Expo Markers (students will use their personal expo markers in Bible class to use on individual dry erase boards)
- Pencil Pouch (**optional**)
- English Standard Version Bible
- 1 Locker Shelf (if desired)
- 1 subject Notebooks (these will be used for the following classes: Math, English, Bible, Leadworthy, Spanish; it would be a good idea to get a few extras)
- 3-hole punch plastic folders with pockets (6 total; used to hold handouts; one for each subject; placed in binder)
- 4 x 6 index cards
