I received official travel approval from ABWE on Wednesday, August 26, and immediately re-booked my flight! My new departure date is September 15, 2020! I truly appreciate the prayers of family and friends as many of you have partnered with me to pray for open borders and the adjustment and/or removal of travel restrictions. This process has been another testing of my faith and my flexibility in many ways, but the Lord has remained faithful even in all the uncertainties. Now that my definite date of departure is so close, I can hardly wrap my mind around it!

As my time in the states grows shorter, I am both excited and nervous to transition to the field. The months/years I have spent raising support, preparing, packing, and waiting (and waiting), have seemed long at times, but looking back, God has kept me busy along the way. I am so thankful for the opportunities, friendships, and experiences that He put in my path throughout this journey. Ephesians 3:20-21 has been an encouraging reminder during this season, that God's power works in our lives "exceeding abundantly" above what we could ask or imagine. His plan is so much better than mine, and I am continuously learning to look to Him instead of leaning on my own understanding.
